



## **GGT-Footing Installation**

These are some guidelines for installing GGT-Footing:

- Irrigate/water the arena.
- Distribute the bales of GGT-Footing evenly throughout the arena.
- Open the bales and either use a harrow or manual labor with rakes to spread out the GGT-Footing across the arena and then work the GGT-Footing into the sand with a harrow or with rakes.
- If using a harrow, please make sure the teeth do not go more than 1.5 in into the sand
- If it is very windy or dusty the arena can be watered when the GGT-Footing is on top of the sand, but it will make it harder and take longer to mix it into the sand
- After the GGT-Footing is mixed with the sand, horses can be let into the arena to run, roll, play in the arena and help with the distribution of GGT-Footing.
- The day after the GGT-Footing has been mixed into the sand a roller-not a harrow-should be used in the arena to smooth the sand.
- Please do not use a harrow/disc for a little while.
- It will take up to one month for the GGT-Footing to be evenly distributed throughout the arena.

During the first couple of weeks after the new footing was added to the arena, you should let the new GGT-Footing surface settle down.
